

National Tsing Hua University Regulations for the Appointment of Emeritus Professors

Passed at the University Teacher Evaluation Committee on April 22, 1999

Approved by the president on May 2, 1999

Passed at the University Teacher Evaluation Committee on April 23, 2020

Approved by the president on April 29, 2020

- Article 1 National Tsing Hua University (hereinafter referred to as the “University”) established these Regulations in accordance with Article 46 of the Organization Regulations to appoint professors with extraordinary contribution to teaching, research, or service with the title of emeritus professor after they retire.
- Article 2 Emeritus professors must meet one of the following conditions:
- I. Full-time professors of the University for at least 15 years with excellent teaching and research performance.
 - II. Enjoys an international reputation for special academic achievement, and has served as a full-time professor at the University for at least five consecutive years.
 - III. Made major contributions to the University’s planning, construction, and development and was recommended by their department.
 - IV. Concurrently held the position of administrative supervisor for six consecutive years with excellent performance.
- Article 3 Six months before the retirement of the University’s professor becomes effective, applications using the conditions specified in Subparagraphs 1 and 2 of the preceding article shall be recommended by the Office of Academic Affairs after data is summarized by the Office of Personnel. The recommendation shall be made by the hiring department for applications using the condition specified in Subparagraph 3 of the preceding article. The recommendation shall be made by the Secretariat for applications using the condition specified in Subparagraph 4 of the preceding article. After a recommendation is made, the Office of Personnel will submit it to the University Teacher Evaluation Committee for review, and then submitted to the president for approval to appoint the emeritus professor.
- Article 4 Unless otherwise stipulated by the law or the University, emeritus professors may use the University’s public facilities the same as current personnel, and their original unit may provide an office and related administrative support.

Article 5 These Regulations were passed by the University Teacher Evaluation Committee and implemented with the approval of the President. The same shall apply to future amendments.
